

PRAIRIE TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES

23 MAPLE DRIVE SPECIAL MEETING/OCTOBER 24, 2002

The special meeting of the Prairie Township Board of Trustees, which was posted in three places in the Township, was called to order at 5:45 a.m. by the Chairman, Mr. Nourse, with Ms. Keller, Mr. Wharton and Ms. Easter present.

Mr. Nourse stated that the purpose of this special meeting is to initiate the process of adopting Access Management Regulations in Prairie Township. Access management guidelines, written on October 18, 2002, were presented for adoption in as much as it initiates the process for final implementation. The two public hearing dates will be November 30th and December 1st at 7:30 p.m. at the Township Hall. These meetings will be advertised in the Columbus Dispatch one time for two weeks preceding the public hearing dates.

Mr. Nourse moved, Mr. Wharton seconded the Board approve initiating the process of adopting, for final implementation, the Access Management Regulations written October 18, 2002. Roll call vote resulted as follows: Mr. Wharton; Aye, Ms. Keller; Aye, Mr. Nourse; Aye.

Mr. Nourse moved, Mr. Wharton seconded the Board approve hiring an intern from Southwestern City Schools, Stacie Blankenship, to assist the Zoning Department. Ms. Blankenship will start effective October 28, 2002 at a rate of \$7.25/hr with a minimum of 12.5 hours per week.

There being no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned at 6:00 a.m.
