



Military Hometown Heroes Banner Program

Guidelines

The Military Hometown Heroes Banner Program was created to honor and recognize military personnel (active, honorably discharged, or deceased) that reside or previously resided in Prairie Township or attended Westland High School.

Banners measure approximately 60" x 20" and will include the service person's name, image, and military branch. Those military men and women who have been honorably discharged will be designated with a white star, those who have died in the line of duty with a gold star, and active duty members will be designated with a blue star.

Guidelines

Honoree must be honorably discharged, deceased, or on active duty with any branch of the United States Military.

Honoree must be a resident or previous resident of Prairie Township or Graduate of Westland High School.

Each banner will list the honoree's name and branch of service and will be proudly displayed on a lamppost along West Broad Street.

Prairie Township will have the sole responsibility of hanging and removing the banner. Once produced and installed, banners shall remain the property of Prairie Township.

The banner will be displayed from Memorial Day through Veterans Day.
